

PAS ASSOCIATION MEMBERSHIP RULES 1991

AS AMENDED FROM TIME TO TIME UPTIL 01.01.2014

1. These Rules shall be called Pakistan Administrative Service Association*
Membership Rules 1991.

2. Definitions

- a. **Association**, wherever occurring in the present rules, means Pakistan Administrative Service Association (PASA), or its predecessor or successor(s)-in-interest.
- b. **Government** means the Government of Pakistan or any provincial government concerned.
- c. **Member** means Member of the PASA
- d. **Prescribed** means “prescribed by these rules” or prescribed by any other Rules framed by the PAS Association or prescribed by the PASA Charter.
- e. **Service**, wherever occurring in the present rules, means Pakistan Administrative Service (P.A.S), or its predecessor or successor(s)-in-interest, including the erstwhile Civil Service of Pakistan (CSP) and the District Management Group (DMG).

3. There shall be three categories of Membership of the Association, namely

- (i) Regular Members
- (ii) Associate Members
- (iii) Coopted Members.

4. Regular Members

The Regular Members shall have the right to contest elections for office bearers of the Federal or a Provincial Chapter concerned of the Association AND to vote in such elections AND to take part in the debates during the general body meetings.

5. Regular Member of the Association shall be

- i- An officer recruited/appointed into the Pakistan Administrative Service through competitive exams or otherwise from the date of his/her joining the Service till his/her active service in the Government.
- ii- Any officer of the erstwhile CSP or the renamed DMG, holding a Government post, in any "Service of Pakistan" within the definition of Art 260 of Constitution, including the officers merged into Secretariat Group upon promotion to BPS-22.
- iii- Any officer of the Provincial Civil Services inducted into the Service within the meaning of S.R.O 88/2014.

6. Associate Members

The Associate Members shall have the right to attend a meeting in connection with the elections for office bearers of the Federal or a Provincial Chapter concerned of the Association AND to take part in the debates during any general body meetings BUT NOT to hold, contest or vote for any office in the Association.

7. All retired or ex officers covered by Rule 5, shall automatically become life-long Associate Members of the Association from the date of their retirement or honorable discharge from Service including the effective date of acceptance of resignation, as the case may be.

8. Coopted Members: The Coopted Members shall have the right to take part in the debates during the general body meetings but NOT to hold any office or contest for any office or to vote in any elections of the Association or to attend an AGM called for election to new officer bearers..

9. The Central Executive Council may coopt a member in the Federal chapter, and a Provincial Executive Council may coopt a member in the provincial chapter concerned of the Association, provided that the person must be associated with practice or teaching of public administration, public policy or public management.

10. Each Member of the Association shall be Member of the Federal Chapter as well as the Provincial chapter concerned within the meaning of section 2 & #3 of the PAS Association Election Bye-Laws 2004.

11. In case of dispute over interpretation, the decision of the Central President of the Association shall be final.

12. The Central Executive Committee has full powers to make, amend or repeal these rules through a simple majority vote of CEC members present and voting.
